**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Sections 40000 et seq. authorizes the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer grant funds to support the Local Solid Waste Enforcement program; and

WHEREAS, Environmental Health is the state-certified Local Enforcement Agency for solid waste in Plumas County; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, and applicant's governing body to declare by Resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Plumas County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of an application to the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery for a Local Enforcement Agency Grant for five (5) years to include Fiscal Year 2023-2024 through Fiscal Year FY 2028-2029.

The Environmental Health Director is hereby authorized and empowered by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors to execute all necessary applications, contracts, agreements, and amendments for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out this program provided, however, that any contract, agreement, or amendment requisitioning goods or services shall remain subject to the Plumas County Purchasing Policy.


