

**RESOLUTION NO. 24- 8896**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE DRAFT CHESTER MAIN STREET COMMUNITY CONNECTIVITY PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Plumas County 2035 General Plan Goal 4.2 identifies upgrading “all State Highways, arterials and collectors, as Complete Streets that accommodate all travel modes with appropriate strategies, based on planning area designation”; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Route 36/Main Street Corridor through the community of Chester does not currently provide adequate multi-modal facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined, through extensive public outreach, that the community desires a Main Street corridor that better utilizes the existing right-of-way for pedestrian and bicycle facilities, transit stops, and public spaces for community activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Draft Chester Main Street Connectivity Plan is consistent with the Plumas County 2035 General Plan and Caltrans’ planning guidance and uses Complete Streets design elements to provide safer and more comfortable mobility options for people of all ages and abilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chester Main Street Connectivity Plan addresses the following key corridor issues that have been identified by the public, high-vehicular speeds, unsafe pedestrian crossings, lack of multimodal connectivity, discontinuous and/or uncomfortable sidewalk conditions, no bicycle facilities, minimal transit amenities, lack of street lighting, heavy truck traffic & speeds, drainage issues & snow management challenges, and lack of public space & amenities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas, State of California, that the Draft Chester Main Street Community Connectivity Plan accurately presents a corridor design that reflects the values and vision of the community of Chester; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas, State of California, that the Chester Main Street Community Connectivity Plan is hereby adopted.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas, State of California, at a regular meeting of the Board held on the 20th day of February 2023, by the following vote:


