



## **Notice of Internet Availability and Ongoing Construction Project**

**Re: Quincy Community**

**Dear PSREC Member,**

Plumas-Sierra Telecommunications (PST) received a Last Mile Federal Funding Account (FFA) grant administered by the California Public Utilities Commission to bring high-speed fiber optic internet services to your area. The grant program's objective is to provide funding for the build-out of last-mile broadband infrastructure to connect underserved communities in California. With this grant, PST can bring high-speed internet access to your home at no cost to you (if you are within the grant area) with exceptional reliability and speeds of up to 1-gigabit per second.

PST crews and contractors have begun the fiber optic build in Quincy and surrounding areas and will continue this work throughout the year. Crews are working on both underground and aerial construction. Due to ongoing construction, cones may be left out, and pedestals might temporarily remain open. The existing coax system will be removed as the fiber-optic infrastructure is built to replace it.

A note for new customers: not all homes within Quincy proper are covered under the grant; therefore, those households may not be eligible for free installation or trenching (if required). Please call 530-832-4126 to determine your home's eligibility and potential installation costs and to be placed on our waitlist. Existing PST customers are being converted at no cost.

### **West Quincy/Downtown**

Aerial construction is ongoing and will continue on and off throughout the summer of 2025. PST anticipates construction completion in fall 2025, with installations beginning in late fall 2025.

### **Northwest Quincy**

Both underground and aerial construction has started on the following streets: Bell Lane, Carol Lane West, and Sullivan Way. PST anticipates construction completion in late fall 2025, with installations beginning in late fall/early winter.

### **East Quincy**

Construction work is ongoing, both underground and aerial, in East Quincy, and it will continue through the summer months. We will be adding our fiber which will replace the coax system currently offering service in east Quincy. The conversion is free. PST anticipates construction completion in late summer/early fall 2025, with installations beginning in early fall 2025.
