

RESOLUTION NO. 16- 8123

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 15-8111 OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLUMAS CALLING AN ADVISORY ELECTION TO ALLOW THE VOTERS OF PLUMAS COUNTY TO VOICE THEIR OPINION REGARDING SEPARATION FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND FORMATION OF A NEW STATE

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2015, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 15-8111 calling for an advisory election pursuant to Elections Code §9603 to allow the voters of Plumas County to voice their opinion regarding separation from the State of California and the formation of a new state; and

WHEREAS, on January 06, 2016, a petition was delivered to the California State Capitol identifying Plumas County as in favor of separating from the State of California and formation of a new state without approval by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above-described Resolution No. 15-8111 is hereby rescinded and of no further force or effect.


