MARRIAGE LICENSES

To obtain a marriage license, both parties must appear together at the County Clerk-Recorder's Office located in Room 102 at the Courthouse, 520 Main Street, Quincy.

- The fee for a regular marriage license is \$60.
- The fee for a confidential marriage license (couple already residing together) is \$65. (Certified copies of this type of marriage license may only be obtained by the parties of the marriage.)
- Each party must present one form of valid photo identification with proof of age.
- NOTE: If either party is under 18 years of age, written consent, counseling and an ORDER of the Superior Court is required before a license can be issued. For information, call the office of the Superior Court at (530) 283-6232 prior to the time to obtain your license.
- You must provide your parents full names (including mother's maiden name) and the state or country in which they were born.
- If either party has been granted a dissolution of marriage (divorce) within 1 year of applying for a new marriage license, a copy of the Notice of Entry of Judgment must be presented for verification at the time the license is issued.
- Licenses take approximately 30 minutes to complete. Please arrive at the office by 4:30 or earlier.

Your marriage license is effective immediately and valid for 90 days after issuance. It can be used anywhere within the State of California ONLY. After the ceremony, the person solemnizing the marriage must return the license to the County Clerk-Recorder where it was issued within 10 days of the marriage.

CEREMONIES - PERFORMED BY DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES

Deputy Commissioners of Civil Marriages perform ceremonies by appointment. You may schedule by calling (530) 283-6218. The fee for the ceremony is \$50 (in addition to the license fee of \$60) and must be paid prior to the time of the ceremony.

MARRIAGE CERTIFICATES - CERTIFIED COPIES

To request a certified copy of a marriage certificate, the marriage license must have been issued in Plumas County. Complete the request form, have your signature notarized and send along with the fee of \$15 and a Self-Addressed, Stamped Envelope to:
