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HAZARDOUS MATERIALS BUSINESS PLAN REQUEST FOR REMOTE FACILITY EXEMPTION

Hazardous Materials Business Plan facilities that operate an unstaffed, remote facility can request an exemption from the CUPA if the facility meets the requirements in Health and Safety Code Section 25507.2. To qualify the facility must be located at least ½ mile from any residential or commercial buildings where people congregate or are employed, facility is not otherwise subject to the requirements of applicable federal law and the facility must be inspected and approved for exemption by the Plumas County CUPA. In addition, the applicant must certify all of the following:

- The Facility is secured and not accessible to the public.
- Warning signs are posted and maintained for hazardous materials pursuant to the California Fire Code.
- A one-time notification and inventory has been entered in CERS.

The inventory is limited to one or more of the following (check any that apply):

- One thousand standard cubic feet of compressed inert gases (asphyxiation and pressure hazards only).
- Five hundred gallons of combustible liquid used as a fuel source.
- Corrosive liquids not to exceed five hundred pounds of extremely hazardous substances, used as electrolytes, and in closed containers
- Five hundred gallons of lubricating and hydraulic fluids
- Twelve hundred gallons of hydrocarbon gas used a fuel source

I certify that the above statements are true and correct. I also certify that I am willing to share hazardous materials storage information with the local fire department, upon request. By signing this application, I request that this facility be exempted from the hazardous material business plan and inventory reporting requirement of California Health and Safety Code section 25506, 25507, 25508.2, 25511, and the associated annual fees. **I furthermore acknowledge this exemption does not relieve me of responsibilities to contain, cleanup or report spills or releases of hazardous materials at this site.**
