PLAN UPDATE: MEETING #1**

Help Plumas County be Hazard-Ready

Plumas County is updating its 2014 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP). Floods, drought, wildfires, and severe weather are just a few of the hazards of concern to the County. While natural hazards such as these cannot be prevented, an LHMP forms the foundation for the County's long-term strategy to reduce disaster losses by breaking the repeated cycle of disaster damage and reconstruction. Communities with a FEMA-approved LHMP are eligible to apply for both pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant funding.

The people most aware of potential hazards are the people that live and work in the affected communities. In addition to plan participation by Plumas County departments and local, state and federal agencies, the County is seeking members of the public to participate in the LHMP Update process.
