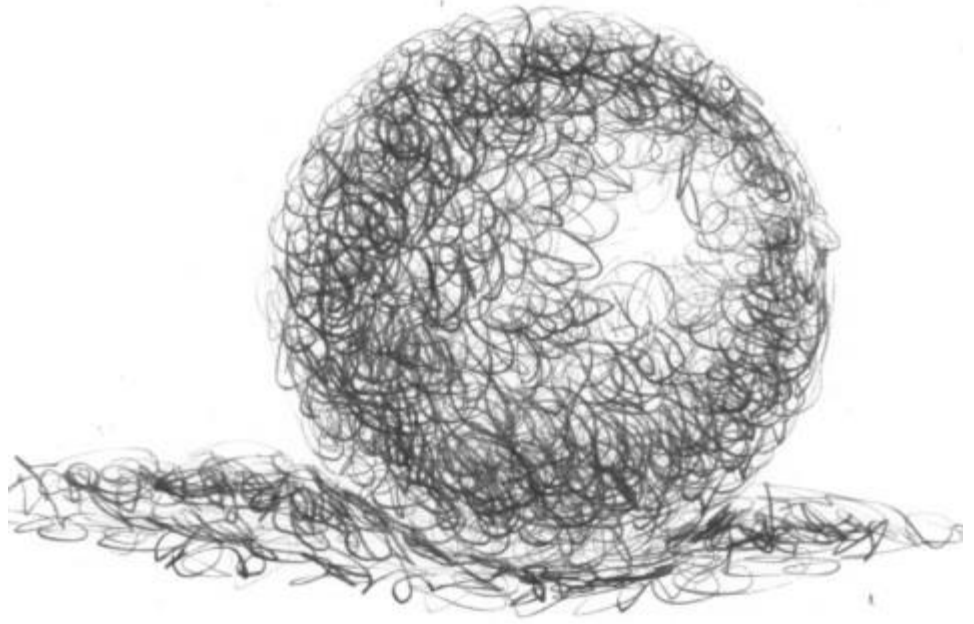


Scumbling is a fun way to shade a drawing and it goes fast!

Scumbling shading works particularly well for portraits and still life. For dark areas make your scribbles quite tight and for light areas space them more.

Composition refers to the organization, arrangement, and combination of objects within the borders, called format, of a drawing space. For a great drawing, you want to bring the eyes of the viewer toward your center of interest within an aesthetically pleasing composition, and keep them within the format.

A **good composition** is one where the **artist** controls the movement of the viewer's eye to a beneficial result. We can do this by a number of means, such as reinforcing the focal point with the Rule of Thirds, implied lines, contrast of value and selective color saturation.
