

2020 PLUMAS COUNTY STUDENTS FLU VACCINATIONS CHANGES!!!

Plumas County Public Health Agency's annual school Flu Vaccination clinics have changed this year, due to COVID-19 and distance learning.

Due to children not being in session this semester, the annual flu clinics at the schools have changed. Plumas County Public Health Agency has scheduled flu vaccination clinics in each area to assist with vaccinating school aged children. In order to ensure a quick and safe environment for everyone the vaccination will be conducted at each person's vehicle.



Important information

- Flu mist (nasal spray) will be available
- At scheduled time (Noon-2:00 pm), drive to designated location and park as directed in parking space. A nurse will go to your vehicle and vaccinate all appropriate persons.
- Students who drive may be vaccinated without parent/guardian present if the Flu Vaccine Form has been completed and signed by parent/guardian
- The regular drive-thru flu clinics are scheduled for October 12-14th. The October 19-22 clinics are to assist with vaccination of school aged children.
- **Face covering should be worn during event.**
