



Plumas County Invites Comments on the Public Review Draft 2020 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) Update

Plumas County is developing a 2020 Update to the 2014 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP). Hazard mitigation means any sustained action taken to reduce or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from natural hazards. Wildfire, floods, drought, and severe weather are just a few of the hazards of concern. While natural hazards such as these cannot be prevented, the LHMP forms the foundation for the County's long-term strategy to reduce disaster losses. The overall update process began in January 2020 with an initial public meeting and the establishment of a Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee (HMPC) comprised of representatives from the County; special districts; other agencies and organizations; key local, regional, and state stakeholders; and the public. The Plan is scheduled to be finalized and submitted to the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in October 2020.
