All branches are open for curbside service only, starting Nov 10 2020. Contact us in advance by phone or email so your holds are ready for pick-up, but appointments are not required. Not all items will be immediately available due to quarantine restrictions and other health and safety measures. Book drops will continue to be open 24/7. The Zip Book Program is still running during this time. Current programming like *Fall Into Reading* will continue and be modified for curbside service only.
