CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS TRAINING STANDARD (IN ACCORDANCE WITH 26165PC-AB2103)

All Plumas County Sheriff's Office approved firearms training providers must ensure the following minimum Live - Fire training standards are successfully accomplished. The Live-Fire Course **shall** be demonstrated with at least the primary firearm the respective individual plans to carry. All additional firearms require a qualification of at least 15 rounds per firearm.

Live-Fire Course

Distance	Rounds (Total 36 – For the primary firearm)
3 yards	6
5 yards	8
7 yards	10
10 yards	12

[Range training shall not require shooting from 25 yards or more.](#)

Target:

The target should be comparable to a B-27-CB silhouette target. A passing score is defined as all 36 rounds being placed within the # 7 ring of the target for the primary firearm. For all additional firearms the shooter qualifies with all 15 rounds (per firearm) **MUST** be placed within the #7 ring of the target.
