Access to subject property at the time of county approval is partially served solely by a road subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Agriculture.

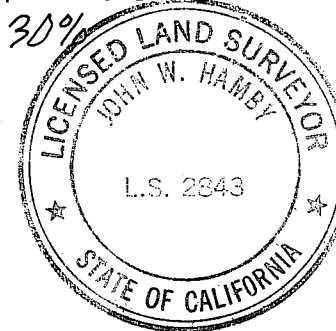

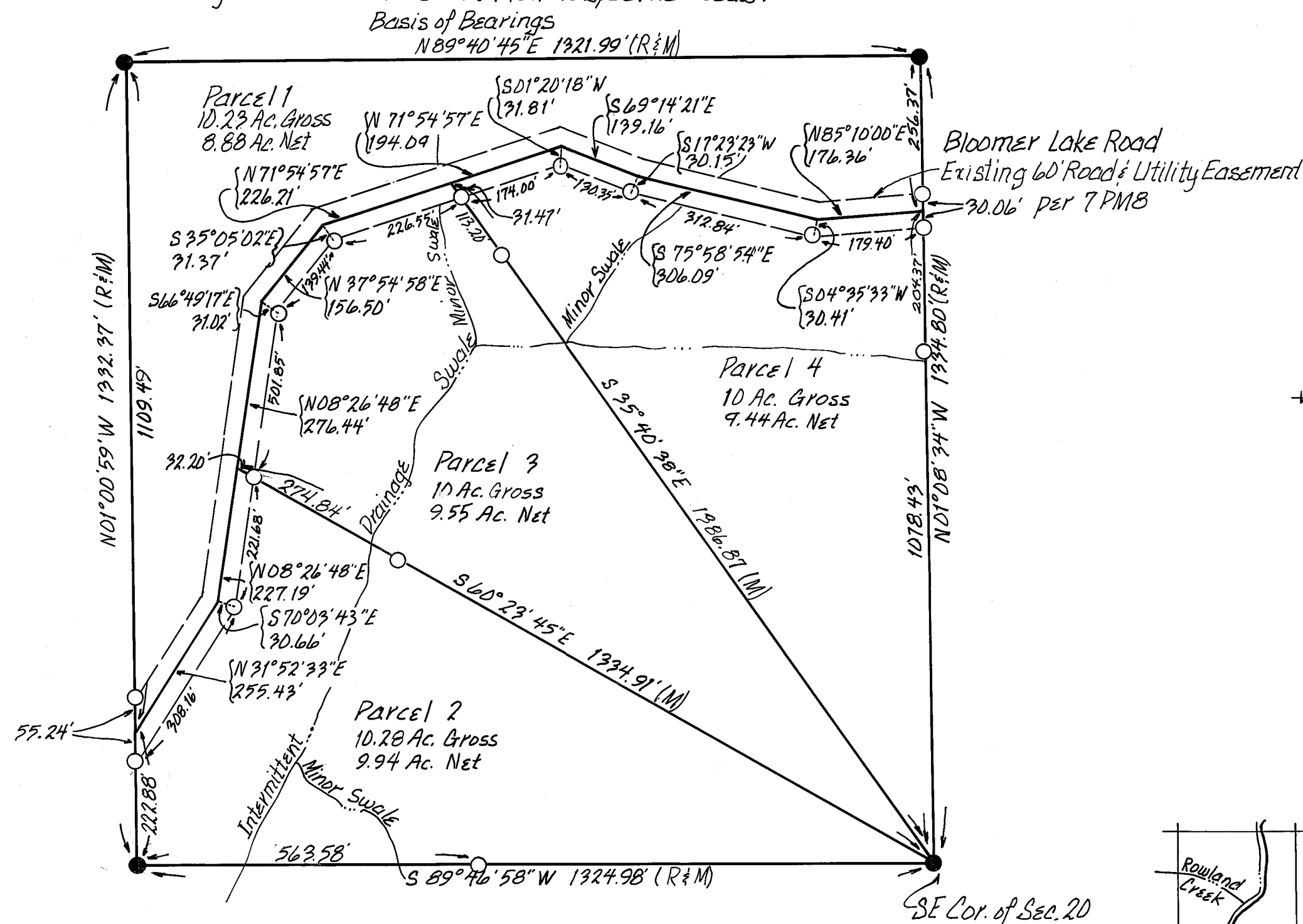

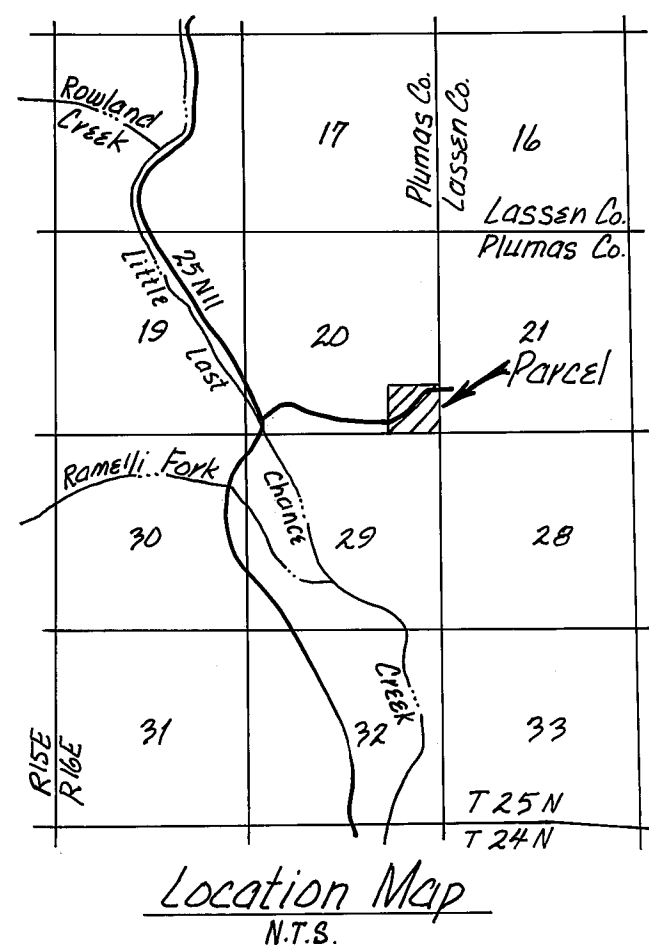
