



NOTES

Sewage disposal for Parcels 1, 3 and 4 will be by means of on-site individual septic tanks and final disposal to off-site existing community leachfield, permit #3723 finalized October 19, 1995. Septic tanks are to be installed under permit by Environmental Health Department.

Grading shall be limited to the period of May through October.

Exposed areas shall be revegetated and covered with straw or mulch before November 1st.

Straw bales or silt fencing shall be installed at the toe of exposed slopes exceeding 10 percent prior to November 1st.

Grading and building permits shall show areas where grading occurs on slopes of 10 percent grade or greater.

Emergency water for fire protection shall be provided before final inspection for building construction as set forth in Article 10 of Chapter 4 of Title 9 of the Plumas County Code.

If it is desired to place leachfield outside of the recorded designated leachfield areas all requirements set forth in Plumas County Code chapter 6 apply and must be met.
