

RECORD OF SURVEY

OF A RETRACEMENT OF SECTION 7 AND A POR. OF SECTION 18, T. 22 N., R. 12 E., M.D.B. & M.

PLUMAS COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

NOTES

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap, from remains of original Gov't. bearing trees per Hall, 1881: a 24" stump bears S83°E, 35.60 ft. (S83°E, 35.64 ft.); a 30" snag with old blase bears S38°30'W, 32.43 ft. (S38°30'W, 32.3 ft.) Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 28" pine, N75°30'E, 83.17 ft.; 16" fir, N39°15'W, 43.26 ft. Fd. a 3/4" iron pin in a mound of stone S88°45'E, 17.14 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap by single proportion. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 20" pine, N43°W, 48.6 ft.; 14" pine, N22°30'E, 48.5 ft.; 24" pine, S39°E, 9.5 ft.; 18" pine, S38°W, 11.1 ft. Fd. a 2" iron pipe N82°W, 2.23 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap by single proportion. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 47" fir, N06°E, 29.7 ft.; 42" pine, S01°30'E, 28.6 ft.

Fd. orig. gov't. corner, a 30" spruce, now 40" dead spruce, per Keddie, 1872. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 24" fir, N52°W, 41.1 ft.; 24" fir, N21°30'E, 48.5', 22" fir, S59°W, 42.8 ft.; 26" pine, S24°E, 20.4 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap from orig. Gov't. bearing trees per Hall, 1881; 30" spruce, now 36", N55°E, 18.50 ft.; 50" spruce, now a 50" stump, S36°15'W, 14.5 ft. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 20" cedar, N21°30'W, 31.6 ft.; 16" sugar pine, at top of break, S61°E, 27.0 ft.

Replaced tip of post in mound of stone with a 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap. Fd. orig. Gov't 26" pine, called spruce, per Keddie, 1872, with Forest Service tag on east face, which bears S86°30'W, 10.8 ft. (S87°30'W, 7.9 ft.). Blazed and scribed new bearing tree as follows: 16" spruce, S57°E, 6.85 ft.

Fd. mound of stone with decayed wood center S08°E, 23.8 ft. from 24" fir stump. Log alongside scribed SXII TXXIIN RXIE. No orig. gov't. B.T.'s. Accepted mound as best evidence of orig. corner. Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Beaches and Parks brass cap. Blazed and scribed new B.T.'s as follows: 22" sugar pine N18°W, 4.5 ft.; 14" fir, S85°W, 16.1 ft.; 12" pitch pine, S10°E, 18.9 ft.; 12" pine, N84°E, 18.5 ft. Fd. 1 1/2" iron pipe in mound of stone S89°W, 68.89 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap by single proportion. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 32" fir S85°E, 45.9 ft.; 30" pine, N15°E, 16.1 ft.

Fd. a 1" iron pipe in the location of the orig. Gov't. post, as verified by Plumas County Surveyor Flanagan. Replaced the 1" iron pipe with a 1 1/2" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 40" pine, N55°30'W, 171.2 ft.; 16" fir, N05°30'E, 116.1 ft.; 14" fir, S32°30'W, 81.8 ft.; 15" sugar pine, S18°30'E, 71.9 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap by single proportion, in slide area. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 26" pine, N80°W, 187.4 ft.; 14" fir, S24°E, 65.3 ft.

Set 3/4" iron pipe with Standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap in center of mound of stone per Hall, 1881. Orig. gov't. 24" pitch pine, now 36", bears S73°30'W, 50 ft., (S77°W, 50.2 ft.). Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: 30" pitch pine, S84°30'W, 52.2 ft.; 14" pitch pine, S84°15'E, 79.3 ft.

Fd. Bureau of Land Management brass cap with bearing trees, per Helster, 1942: 6" fir, now 8", bears N16°E, 46.2 ft., (N15°30'E, 46.2 ft.); 9" fir, now 11", bears S32°E, 96.4 ft., (S31°45'E, 96.4 ft.); 8" fir, now 10", bears (S46°W, 77.9 ft.); 9" fir, now 11", bears N20°W, 68.6', (N28°W, 68.6 ft.).

Set 3/4" iron pipe with standard Div. of Beaches and Parks brass cap from orig. Gov't. 36" pitch pine, now 49", line tree, per Hall, 1881. Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows: a 14" fir, N08°10'53"W, 20.52 ft.; a 12" fir, S68°48'39"W, 24.68 ft.; set a Forest Service tag on a 4 1/2 ft. spruce, West 170 ft. Spruce bears West of flowing creek.
