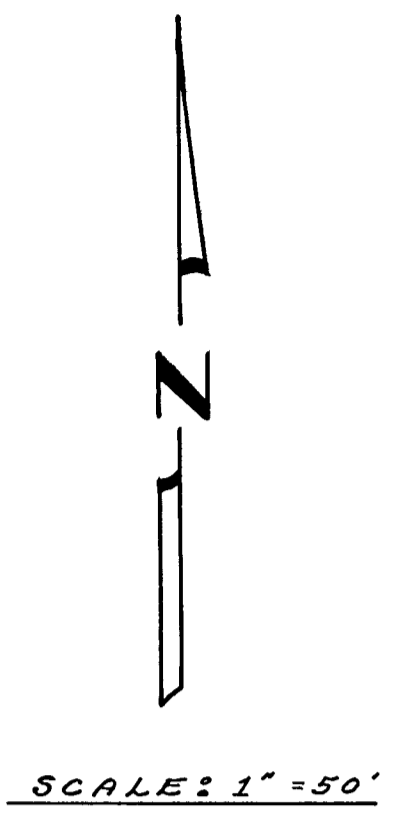


- LEGEND**
