

NOTES

1. Length and bearing of N. & E. lines of Sec. 17 determined by two independent traverses, the results of which were in substantial agreement.
2. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 17 not set but could be set by single proportionate measurements from data obtained from this survey.
3. N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. of Sec. 17 (between Secs. 8 & 17) lost, reset by single proportionate measurements between the NE and NW Cors of Sec. 17. The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. thus set agreed very closely with such terrain features called for in original survey notes as could still be identified on the ground.

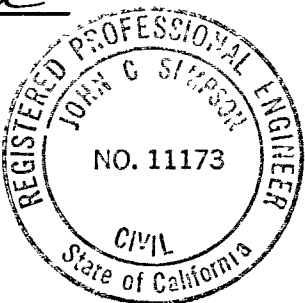
