



**NOTE 1:** This line is accepted as parallel to Section line, within reasonable limits of surveying accuracy, as it is based on R/S 2-36 & P/M 4-106.

**NOTE 2:** The location in the original conveyance to Sheehan, recorded June 11, 1951 (43 O.R. 260) was obviously based upon R/S 1-58. However, subsequent surveys by W. R. Jennings RCE 6185, W. B. Grimes RCE 7294, G. C. Henderson L.S. 3297, and M. J. McBean L.S. 2702, utilize a different Section corner location which appears to lie in a more reasonable location. Therefore, the Deed call to the true section line was used to establish the boundaries of the Wright property.
