BASIS OF BEARINGS

THE BASIS OF BEARINGS IS ASTRONOMIC NORTH AS DETERMINED BY SOLAR OBSERVATION (ALTITUDE METHOD) ON JUNE 22, 1984 NEAR THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 14. LATITUDE = 34° 50' 21" LONGITUDE = 121° 10' 07"

- ### NOTES
- 1) SET USFS MONUMENT IS A BERNSTEIN A-1-BR BREAK-OFF MONUMENT; A 2 1/2" DIAMETER ALUMINUM PIPE W/ MAGNETIC BASE DESIGNED TO SEPARATE UPON IMPACT AND A 3 1/2" DIAMETER ALUMINUM CAP MARKED AS SHOWN.
 - 2) TOTAL GOVERNMENT LANDS IN SECTION 14 IS 379.85 ACRES; TOTAL PRIVATE LANDS IS 291.97 ACRES.
 - 3) ORIGINAL SURVEY PERFORMED BY EDUARD A VON SCHMIDT COMPLETED SEPTEMBER 27, 1875.
 - 4) THE COMPLETED PRIMARY CONTROL SURVEY AROUND THE EXTERIOR OF SECTION 14 REVEALED AN EXCESS OF 295 FT. (4.97 CHS) ALONG THE WEST LINE AND 244 FT. (3.70 CHS) ALONG THE SOUTH HALF OF THE EAST LINE. THE ORIGINAL TOPO CALLS ALONG THE WEST LINE WERE PICKED UP WITH THE SURVEY AND INDICATED THE EXCESS MOST LIKELY FALLS IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE WEST LINE. THAT PLACED THE PRIMARY SEARCH AREA FOR THE WEST QUARTER CORNER ± 2640 FT. NORTH OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 14 (ON THE EDGE OF THE MEADOW IN THE MIDDLE OF MINING ACTIVITY). HOWEVER, SINCE A THOROUGH SEARCH OF THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SEARCH AREAS TURNED UP NO EVIDENCE AND SINCE INTERPRETATION OF THE TOPO CALLS YIELDS MORE THAN ONE LOCATION, THE CORNER WAS PRORATED.
