This corner was replaced from Corners No. 1 and No. 4 of the Blue Gravel Location, Lot 60, as shown on the Plat of Mineral Survey No. 3514, of the Excelsior Mining Claims, surveyed by Arthur W. Keddie in 1897. Detail of Corner Location is shown on Sheet 2. From the Quarter Corner as located, the site of the Corbett Hotel in Gibsonville bears S 18°05'W; G.L.O. Record is S 17°30'W. The East Quarter Corner of Section 19 as determined from the Original Bearing Tree, bears

N 33°03'E from the site of the Corbett Hotel; G.L.O. Record is N 33°E.
The site of the Corbett Hotel was located with the use of a hand drawn map made by the late Truman Gould, who for many years ran the La Porte Store, and as a young man lived in Gibsonville where his father had a saloon across the street from the hotel.
This position was verified by information provided by Leroy Post, who is 95 years old and still lives in La Porte. Mr. Post worked in many of the mines in the area and often visited the Corbett Hotel. His independent recollection of its location coincides with that shown on Mr. Gould's map.
If the South Quarter Corner of Section 19 was to be set by single proportion, it would be incompatible with the location of the Corbett Hotel which is cited in the G.L.O. field notes.
