BASIS OF BEARING

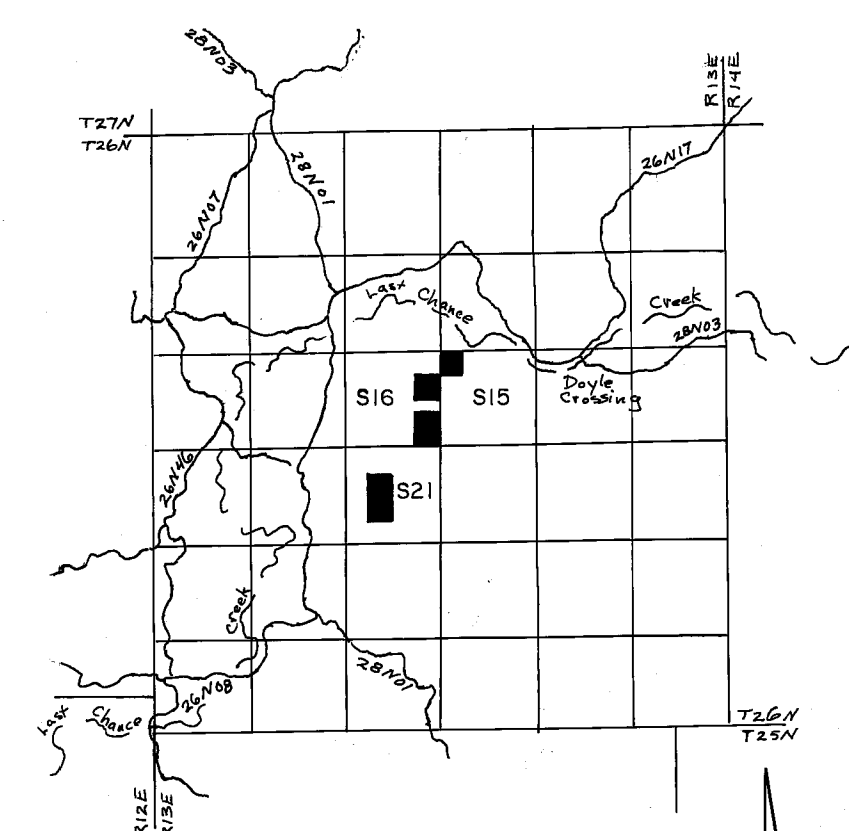
