

SURVEY HISTORY

IN AUGUST OF 1877 DEPUTY SURVEYOR L.D. BOND SUBDIVIDED THE SOUTHERLY AND WESTERLY PORTION OF THIS TOWNSHIP, DECLARING THE REST OF THE TOWNSHIP TO BE "BROKEN AND MOUNTAINOUS DEVOID OF VALUABLE TIMBER WITH SOIL UNFIT FOR CULTIVATION."

IN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER OF 1878 DEPUTY SURVEYOR J.A. BENSON COMPLETED THE SUBDIVISION OF THE TOWNSHIP AND THE SURVEY OF THE EAST AND NORTH BOUNDARY AND A SMALL PORTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THE TOWNSHIP.

A DEPENDENT RE-SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY WAS CONDUCTED BY G.L.O. SURVEYOR ROGER F. WILSON IN THE SUMMER OF 1938.

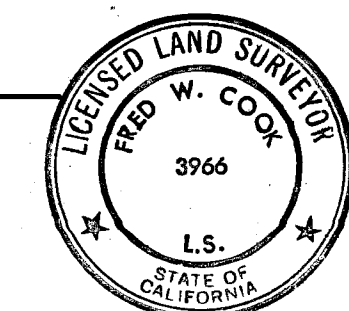
