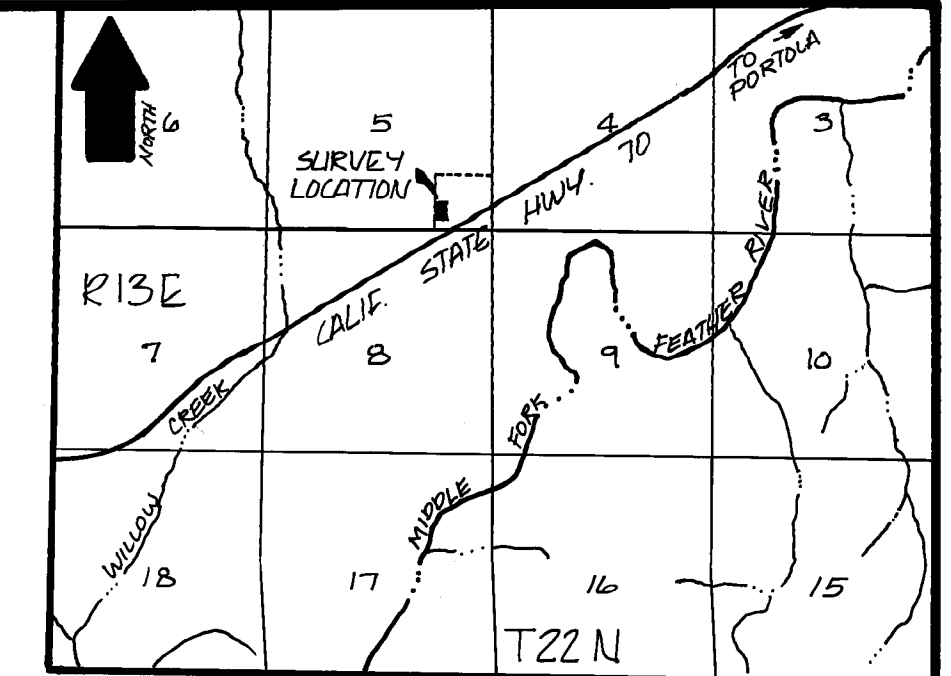


MAP NOTES

- 1) THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 2 AS SHOWN ON THIS RECORD OF SURVEY REFLECTS A LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT APPROVED BY THE PLUMAS COUNTY ZONING ADMINISTRATOR ON MARCH 5, 1986, AND RECORDED IN BOOK 441 AT PAGE 540 PLUMAS COUNTY OFFICIAL RECORDS.
- 2) THERE MAY BE UNDERGROUND WATERLINES APPURTENANT TO THE SHOWN WATER TANK OF WHICH THE LOCATIONS ARE UNKNOWN.
- 3) A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF TIME WAS SPENT IN SEARCH OF SOME OF THE ORIGINAL G.L.D. CORNERS AROUND THE EXTERIOR OF SECTION 5, PARTICULARLY THOSE SECTION CORNERS THAT WOULD HAVE THE MOST EFFECT UPON THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 5 (WEST LINE LOT 2). NO EVIDENCE WAS FOUND AT EITHER THE QUARTER CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 32 AND 5 OR AT THE QUARTER CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 5 AND 8. CORNERS ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 5 HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE BLM IN A SURVEY UNDER SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS (SECTION 4), ALTHOUGH THE COMPLETED SURVEY HAS NOT YET BEEN APPROVED. AT THE SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 AND 8, A DOUBLE PRORATE POSITION WAS MONUMENTED PER 4 P.M. 29. UPON REVIEWING 4 P.M. 29, THE ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES AND SEARCHING FOR THE CORNER, THE MONUMENTED PRORATE POSITION FITS NONE OF THE TOPO CALLS IN THE ORIGINAL NOTES. IN FACT, RETRACING SOME OF THE MORE SPECIFIC TOPO CALLS, THE ORIGINAL CORNER MOST LIKELY FALLS APPROXIMATELY 400 FEET EAST AND 100 FEET NORTH OF THE MONUMENTED PRORATE POSITION. HOWEVER, NO ORIGINAL CORNER EVIDENCE WAS FOUND AND A DEFINITIVE LOCATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER BASED UPON TOPO CALLS WOULD BE SPECULATIVE AT THIS POINT. THEREFORE, I HAVE ACCEPTED THE PREVIOUS SECTIONAL WORK (4 P.M. 29, 5 P.M. 19, T.R.S. 40), BUT BELIEVE THERE IS A PREPONDERANCE OF EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT MY CONJECTURE REGARDING THE GENERAL LOCATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.
