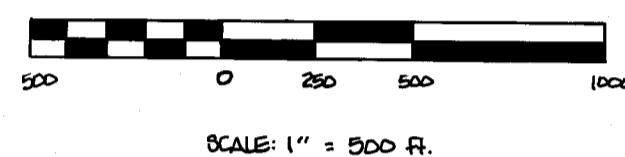


VICINITY MAP

BASIS OF BEARINGS

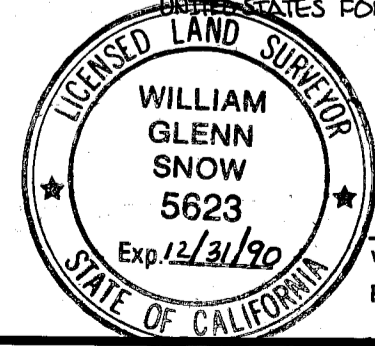

HISTORY OF SURVEYS

IN 1871, ARTHUR W. KEDDIE, UNITED STATES DEPUTY SURVEYOR, PERFORMED THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION LINES OF TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN.
SINCE 1871, MANY PRIVATE ENGINEERS AND SURVEYORS HAVE PERFORMED RESURVEYS OF SECTION 17, T24N, R. 10E., M.D.M.
