MAP NOTES

- 1. THE LOCATION OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 33 WAS ESTABLISHED BY THE DOUBLE PROPORTION METHOD, AS DESCRIBED IN THE MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS, BETWEEN THE SECTION CORNERS AS SHOWN.
2. THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 33 AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 33 WAS TAKEN AS 80 CHAINS FOR PROPORTIONING PURPOSES. THE 1863 TRANSCRIBED GLO NOTES OF EPHRAIM DYER SHOW 81 CHAINS; HOWEVER THIS 81 CHAIN MEASUREMENT WAS NOT NORMAL NOR CONSISTENT WITH THE INTERSECTING EAST-WEST LINES. THE ORIGINAL 1863 GLO NOTES ARE LOST, AND THE FIELD MEASUREMENT BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 33 AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 28 IS MORE NEAR 160 CHAINS (159.93 CHAINS); THEREFORE THE STANDARD MEASUREMENT OF 80 CHAINS IS BELIEVED TO BE INTENDED FOR THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 33.
3. QUARTER AND 1/16 CORNERS WERE ESTABLISHED BY THE SINGLE PROPORTION METHOD AS DESCRIBED IN THE MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS.

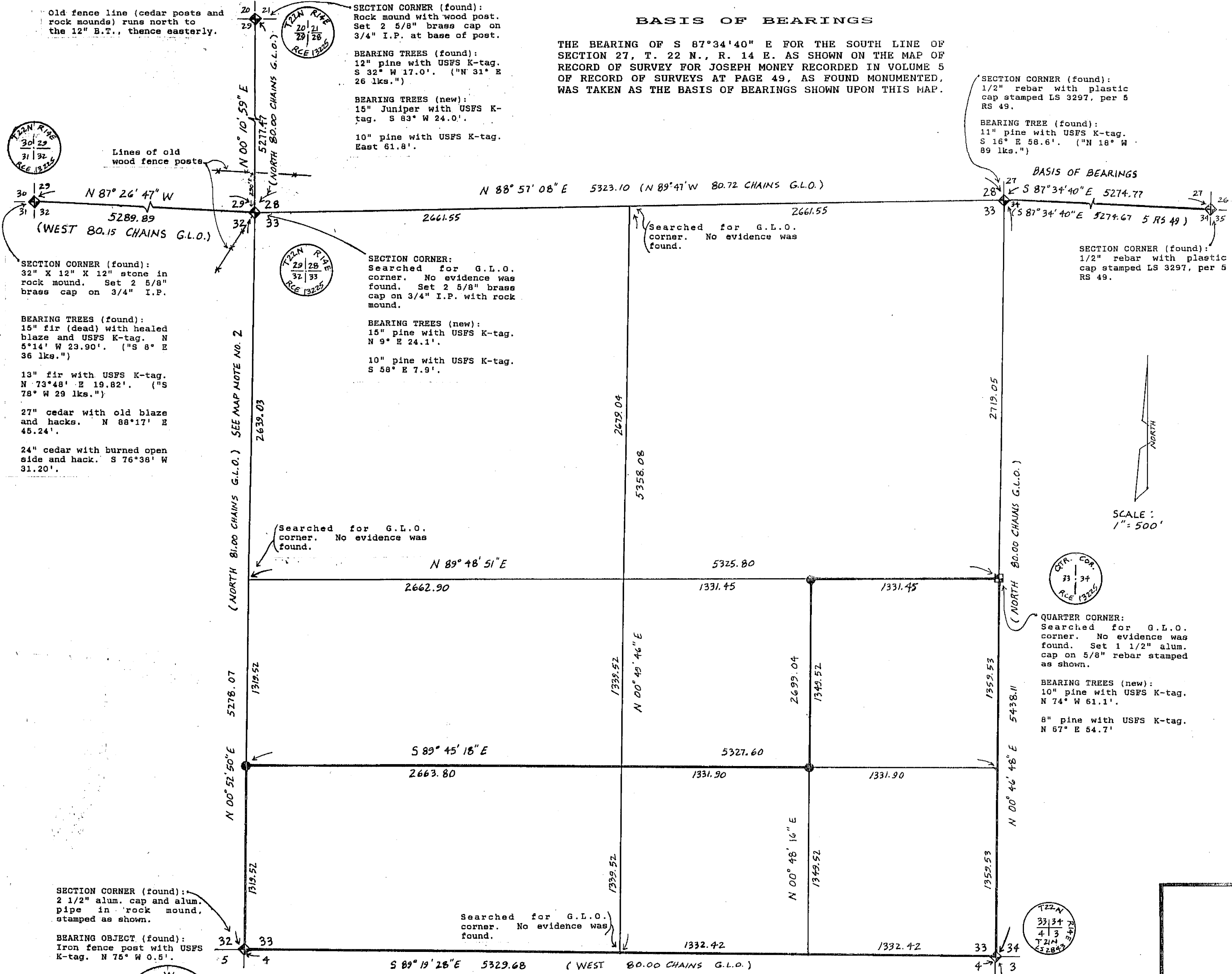

Old fence line (cedar posts and rock mounds) runs north to the 12" B.T., thence easterly.

SECTION CORNER (found): Rock mound with wood post. Set 2 5/8" brass cap on 3/4" I.P. at base of post.

BEARING TREES (found): 12" pine with USFS K-tag. S 32° W 17.0'. ("N 31° E 26 lks.")

BEARING TREES (new): 15" Juniper with USFS K-tag. S 83° W 24.0'.

10" pine with USFS K-tag. East 61.8'.

SECTION CORNER (found): 1/2" rebar with plastic cap stamped LS 3297, per 5 RS 49.

BEARING TREE (found): 11" pine with USFS K-tag. S 16° E 58.6'. ("N 18° W 89 lks.")

SECTION CORNER (found): 32" X 12" X 12" stone in rock mound. Set 2 5/8" brass cap on 3/4" I.P.

BEARING TREES (found): 15" fir (dead) with healed blaze and USFS K-tag. N 51° 4' W 23.90'. ("S 8° E 36 lks.")

13" fir with USFS K-tag. N 73° 48' E 19.82'. ("S 78° W 29 lks.")

27" cedar with old blaze and hacks. N 88° 17' E 45.24'.

24" cedar with burned open side and hack. S 76° 38' W 31.20'.

SECTION CORNER: Searched for G.L.O. corner. No evidence was found. Set 2 5/8" brass cap on 3/4" I.P. with rock mound.

BEARING TREES (new): 15" pine with USFS K-tag. N 9° E 24.1'.

10" pine with USFS K-tag. S 58° E 7.9'.

Searched for G.L.O. corner. No evidence was found.

Searched for G.L.O. corner. No evidence was found.

QUARTER CORNER: Searched for G.L.O. corner. No evidence was found. Set 1 1/2" alum. cap on 5/8" rebar stamped as shown.

BEARING TREES (new): 10" pine with USFS K-tag. N 74° W 61.1'.

8" pine with USFS K-tag. N 67° E 54.7'.

SECTION CORNER (found): 2 1/2" alum. cap and alum. pipe in rock mound, stamped as shown.

BEARING OBJECT (found): Iron fence post with USFS K-tag. N 76° W 0.5'.
