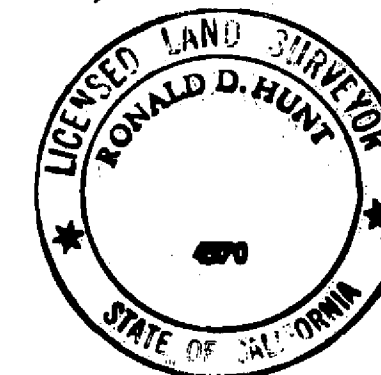

**Basis of Bearing**

True North is based on solar observation and determined by the hour angle method at a station  $58^{\circ}32'25''W$ , 573.33 ft. from the C14 corner of Section 25.

- ② North line of Last Chance No. 1 and section line between sections 25-30: Set ACAP on moderate south slope, and scribed and tagged: 1) 16-in. p.pine  $N72^{\circ}49'W$ , 40.2 ft.; 2) 26-in. p.pine  $N16^{\circ}25'E$ , 45.8 ft.
- ③ Last Chance No. 1, Corner No. 3, M.S. 5519: Found and accepted rock mound and the following BT's per M.S. 5519 notes: 1) dead 60-in. fir  $N01^{\circ}23'E$ , 9.0 ft.; 2) 48-in. fir  $S74^{\circ}03'W$ , 15.5 ft. Set ACAP and scribed and tagged: 1) 12-in. white fir  $N35^{\circ}E$ , 12.8 ft.
- ④ Last Chance No. 2, Corner No. 3, M.S. 5519: Found 39-in. p.pine with scribing per M.S. 5519 notes. Set ACAP  $N86^{\circ}06'W$ , 14.0 ft. from said bearing tree on a gentle southwest slope. Scribed and tagged: 1) 11-in. p.pine  $N45^{\circ}29'W$ , 8.6 ft.

New BLM BT's found are: 1) 8-in. p.pine  $S22^{\circ}W$ , 14.0 ft.; 2) 7-in. p.pine  $N26^{\circ}54'E$ , 15.2 ft.
- ② W 1/4, sections 24-25: Set ACAP on gentle, open south slope, and scribed and tagged: 1) 11-in. p.pine  $N32^{\circ}43'E$ , 41.5 ft.; 2) 14-in. p.pine  $S10^{\circ}36'W$ , 41.4 ft.
- ③ 1/4 Corner, sections 24-25: Found standard BLM BCIP dated 1973 on a brushy south slope, from which bear the original government BT's: 1) 2 1/2 ft. down p.pine with traces of scribing  $S59^{\circ}04'E$ , 40.0 ft. (record 559.4, 54 lks.); 2) 2-ft. uprooted and decaying p.pine with axe marks  $N34^{\circ}31'E$ , 54.8 ft. (record  $N33^{\circ}E$ , 83 lks.) Found BLM new BT's: 1) 15-in. p.pine  $S13^{\circ}53'W$ , 14.9 ft.; 2) 12-in. p.pine  $N58^{\circ}46'W$ , 13.3 ft.
- ④ Section Corner 24-25 only: Found standard BLM BCIP dated 1924 in a rock mound 95-ft. south of a dirt road, and the following original BT's: 1) 4 ft. p.pine stump  $S39^{\circ}38'W$ , 4.8 ft. - ⑥ NE 1/4, section 25: Set ACAP on a flat 100 ft. north and 70 ft. west of Spring Creek. Scribed and tagged: 1) 10-in. p.pine  $N8^{\circ}25'E$ , 42.3 ft.; 2) 14-in. p.pine  $S7^{\circ}02'E$ , 27.6 ft.
- ⑦ N 1/4, section 25 only: Set ACAP on gentle northwest slope. Scribed and tagged: 1) 6-in. white fir  $S39^{\circ}47'W$ , 18.3 ft.; 2) 8-in. white fir  $N51^{\circ}08'W$ , 36.8 ft.
- ⑧ 1/4 Corner, sections 24-25: Found standard BLM BCIP dated 1973 in rock mound on gentle south slope, and the following original BT's: 1) 2 1/2 ft. stump hole of decaying pine  $S81^{\circ}25'E$ , 59.9 ft. (record 583.5, 90 lks.); 2) 36-in. p.pine with open face with visible scribing  $N51^{\circ}18'W$ , 46.4 ft. (record  $N71^{\circ}W$ , 72 lks.) Also found new BLM BT's: 1) 12-in. p.pine  $N65^{\circ}30'E$ , 9.8 ft.; 2) 15-in. p.pine  $S26^{\circ}29'W$ , 9.9 ft.
- ⑨ CW 1/4, section 25: Found 1 1/4-in. iron pipe properly stamped by LS 2217 per 2 R/S 28 on a steep, brushy southeast slope some 200 ft. west of a dirt road. Both BT's are dead or gone. Scribed and tagged: 1) 15-in. p.pine  $N86^{\circ}27'W$ , 20.0 ft.; 2) 30-in. p.pine  $N50^{\circ}20'W$ , 97.2 ft.
- ⑩ C 1/4, section 25: Found 1 1/4-in. iron pipe properly stamped by LS 2217 per 2 R/S 28 on gentle south slope. Both of Bailiff's BT's are in good condition: 1) 30-in. p.pine  $N42^{\circ}49'W$ , 92.4 ft.; 2) 16-in. p.pine  $N76^{\circ}13'E$ , 31.7 ft.
- ⑪ CE 1/4, section 25: Found 1 1/4-in. iron pipe properly stamped by LS 2217 per 2 R/S 28 on gentle south slope. Both of Bailiff's BT's are in good condition: 1) 30-in. p.pine  $N42^{\circ}49'W$ , 92.4 ft.; 2) 16-in. p.pine  $N76^{\circ}13'E$ , 31.7 ft.
- ⑫ 1/4 Corner, section 25 only: Found BLM BCIP dated 1924 in a rock mound on a gentle southwest slope some 100 ft. south of jeep road. Found: 1) original 26-in. p.pine  $N78^{\circ}18'W$ , 30.5 ft. (record West, 40 lks.); 2) dead 18-in. p.pine scribed,  $N6^{\circ}07'W$ , 10.8 ft.
- ⑬ 1/4 Corner, sections 25-30: Found and accepted 8" x 10" x 30" upright rock in rock mound. Found original 2-ft. pine badly decayed  $N31^{\circ}55'E$ , 58.2 ft. (record  $N40^{\circ}E$ , 87 lks.). Set ACAP properly stamped, and scribed and tagged: 1) 18-in. incense cedar  $S74^{\circ}17'W$ , 12.4 ft.; 2) 23-in. incense cedar  $S01^{\circ}01'W$ , 31.7 ft.
- ⑭ Last Chance No. 1, Corner No. 4, M.S. 5519: Found and accepted 4" x 4" x 3" post in rock mound for the northeast corner of Last Chance No. 1 Mining Claim and property corner. Found: 1) 16-in. p.pine  $N11^{\circ}22'W$ , 24.2 ft.; 2) 14-in. p.pine  $N47^{\circ}48'E$ , 27.1 ft. Set ACAP in place of post stamped "Property Corner, L.C. 1 COR. 4, LS 4570, 1988".
