## HISTORY of SURVEYS

THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, WAS PERFORMED BY MILTON SANTEE, DEPUTY SURVEYOR, DURING THE MONTHS OF SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1879.
