

HISTORY of SURVEYS

THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, WAS PERFORMED BY MILTON SANTEE, DEPUTY SURVEYOR, DURING THE MONTHS OF SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1879.

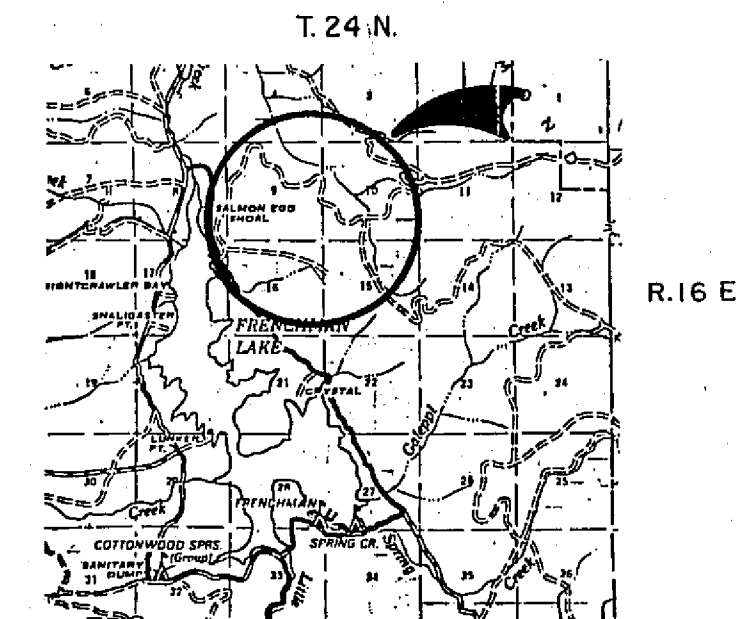

THE BASIS OF BEARINGS FOR THIS SURVEY IS A SOLAR OBSERVATION TAKEN AT THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN. THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 16 HAS A LATITUDE OF 39°-56'-03" AND A LONGITUDE OF 120°-12'-07".

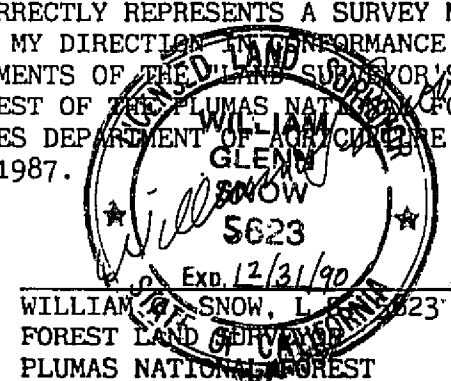
