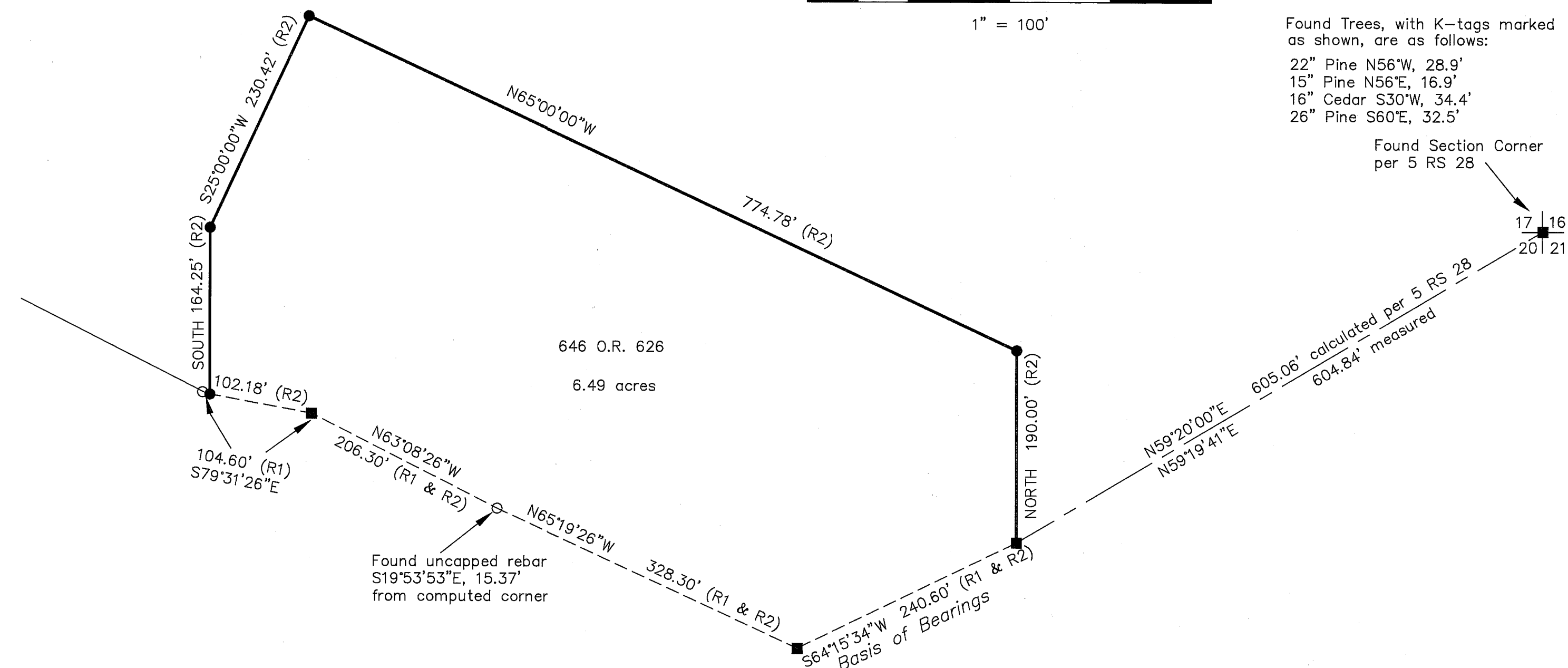
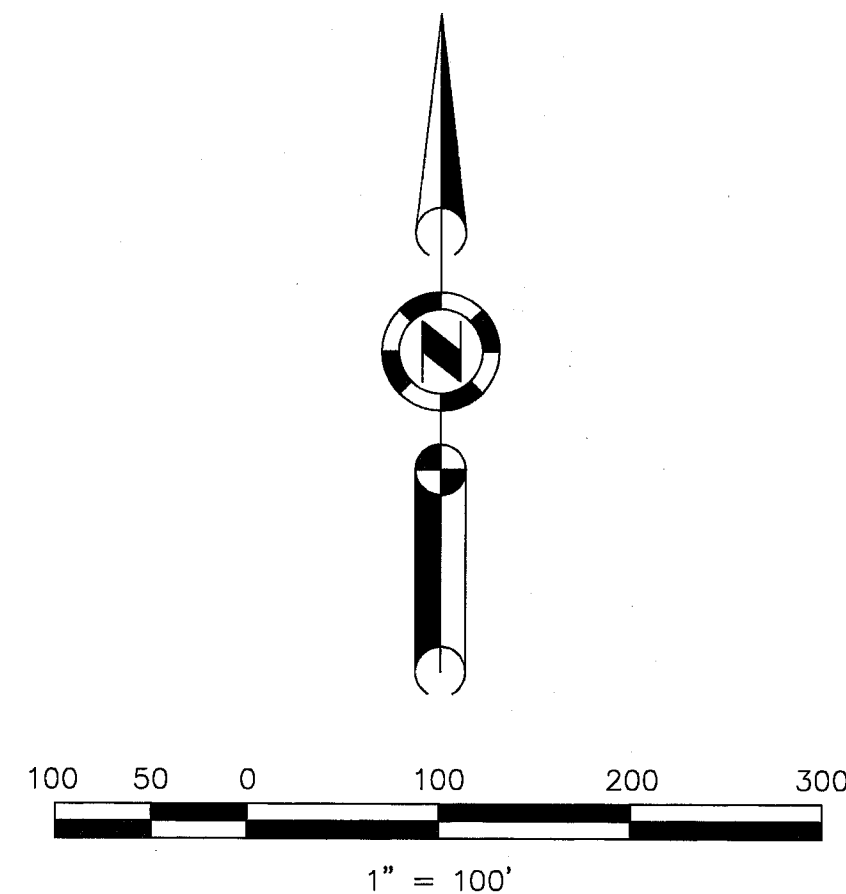


The Basis of Bearings of this survey is line shown as

of Record of Surveys at page 28, Plumas County records.

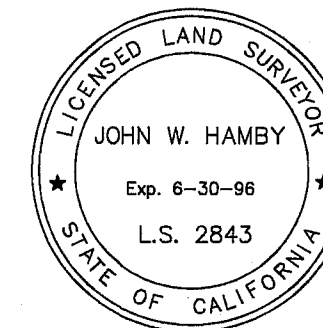

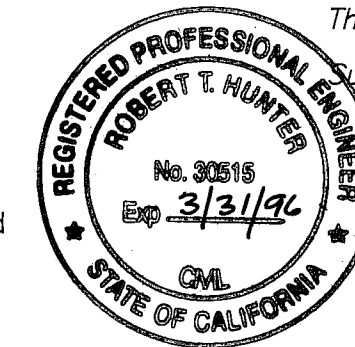
