

### NOTES FOR BREAKDOWN OF SECTION 28

THE E1/4 CORNER AND ALL ORIGINAL INTERIOR 1/16 CORNERS OF SEC.28 WERE SEARCHED FOR, BUT NO ORIGINAL EVIDENCE WAS FOUND. WE ACCEPTED THE S1/16 COR. BETWEEN S28-S27 SHOWN ON: (P.M. 9-46) AS BEING THE LOCATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER. THE LINE FROM THE SE CORNER OF SEC. 28 AND THIS S1/16 COR. WAS EXTENDED NORTHERLY AN EQUAL DISTANCE TO LOCATE THE E1/4 COR. OF SEC. 28. SINCE THE N1/4 COR. OF SEC. 28 WAS NEVER SET WE USED THE PROCEDURES DETAILED IN SECTION 3-88 OF THE 1973 BLM MANUAL OF SURVEY INSTRUCTIONS TO SUBDIVIDE THIS SECTION.

### NOTES FOR BREAKDOWN OF SECTION 29


THE FIRST BREAKDOWN OF SECTION 29 WAS SHOWN ON RECORD OF SURVEY (BOOK-3, PAGE-106) BY LS 2846. THAT SURVEY ESTABLISHED THE CENTER OF SECTION 29 AS THE MID-POINT OF A LINE BETWEEN THE E1/4 & W1/4 OF SECTION 29. SECTION 3-88 OF THE 1973 MANUAL OF SURVEY INSTRUCTIONS BY B.L.M. DESCRIBES THE PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW FOR ESTABLISHING THE CENTER LINES OF FRACTIONAL SECTIONS WHERE ALL THE 1/4 CORNERS WERE NOT SET BY THE ORIGINAL GLO SURVEYOR. WE ESTABLISHED THE C1/4 OF SEC. 29 BY USING A MEAN OF THE BEARINGS OF THE EAST AND WEST LINES OF SEC. 29 FOR THE N-S CENTERLINE AND IT'S INTERSECT WITH A STRAIGHT LINE BETWEEN THE E1/4 AND W1/4 CORNERS AS DESCRIBED IN THE MANUAL. OUR SURVEY IS IN CONFLICT WITH ALL THE PINS SET ALONG THE N-S CENTERLINE OF SEC. 29 AND THE MOST EASTERLY LINE OF PARCEL-2 AS SHOWN ON R.S. 3-106 AND OTHER SUBSEQUENT SURVEYS USING THESE MONUMENTS, SUCH AS: (P.M. 2-57; P.M. 2-67; & P.M. 6-50). THE E1/16 COR. ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 29 AS SHOWN ON: R.S 3-106 WAS FOUND AND ACCEPTED BY THIS SURVEY.

### NOTES FOR BREAKDOWN OF SECTION 33

THE BREAKDOWN OF SECTION 33 AS SHOWN ON (R.S.9-11) AGREES WITH OUR MEASUREMENTS AND IS ACCEPTED. THE CW1/16 OF S33 WAS CALCULATED BY SINGLE PROPORTION ALONG THE E-W CENTERLINE OF THE SECTION 33 AS SHOWN ON THAT RECORD AND THE EXIST. SW1/16 CORNER WAS ACCEPTED.

### PROPERTY LINE MARKING NOTE:

THE CHY COMPANY PROPERTY LINES SHOWN AS BOLD LINES IN THESE DRAWINGS WERE ENHANCED BY BLAZING TREES, HANGING FLAGGING, NAILING SHINERS IN BASE OF TREES ALONG LINES. SIX FOOT TALL STEEL POSTS WERE SET AT RANDOM INTERVALS ALONG LINES, THESE POSTS ARE WITHIN 0.5' OF PROPERTY LINE.


