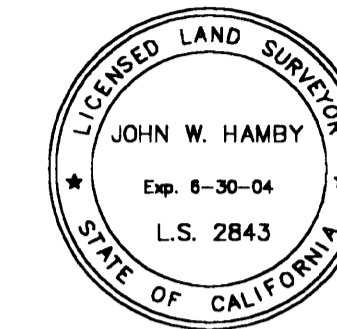


Basis of Bearings

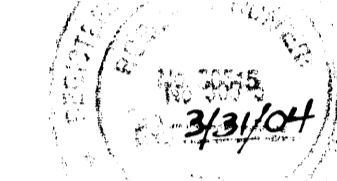

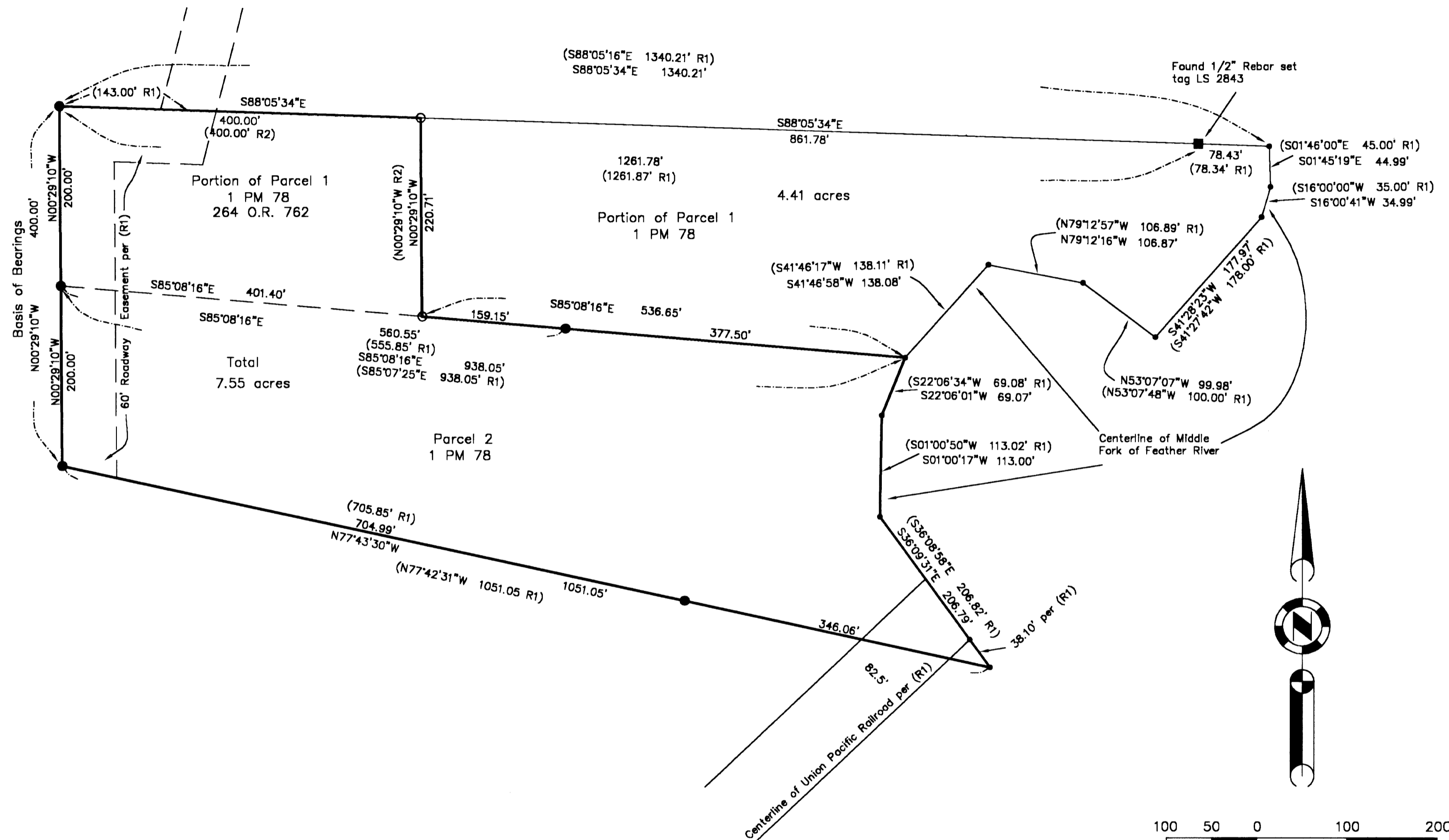
