



A STANDARD LS 7794 MONUMENT IS A 1/2" DIAMETER REBAR WITH A 1 1/2" DIAMETER ALUMINUM CAP STAMPED "RICHARD KNOETTGEN LS 7794".

THE WESTERLY AND EASTERLY LINE OF THE LANDS SURVEYED AS DESCRIBED IN BOOK 368 OF OFFICIAL RECORDS ON PAGE 37 AND ITS SECOND LEAD-IN COURSE FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 1, BLOCK 14, "A MAPS 36, WERE ALL HELD TO BE PARALLEL WITH ODDIE WAY. THE WESTERLY AND EASTERLY LINE OF THE LANDS DESCRIBED IN 145 O.R. 400 ARE PARALLEL WITH THE EAST LINE OF THE TOWN OF QUINCY. THE EXCESS LAND RESULTING FROM THIS INTERPRETATION OF THE DEEDS WAS GIVEN TO THE LANDS DESCRIBED IN 145 O.R. 400. THE LOCATION OF THE EXISTING WOODEN FENCE BETWEEN THE TWO LANDS WAS USED AS THE BASIS FOR THIS DECISION.
