



Extra COVID-19 Vaccine Doses for Immunocompromised People

On August 16, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended [additional doses of mRNA vaccines for COVID-19 for moderately to severely immunocompromised people.](#)

This includes people with:

- Active treatment for cancer
- An organ transplant
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- A stem-cell transplant within 2 years
- Moderate to severe immunodeficiency
- Active treatment with corticosteroids or any other drugs that suppress the immune system

People with any of these conditions who have already received two doses of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine for COVID-19 are advised to talk with their doctor about whether an additional vaccine dose could be beneficial for them.

There is not enough information at this time to recommend an additional dose for immunocompromised people who received the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.

If you and your doctor determine that an additional dose is appropriate, the vaccine is available in Plumas County at Eastern Plumas Healthcare, Plumas District Hospital, Quincy Pharmacy and Rite-Aid in Quincy.

Additional vaccine doses (booster shots) are not approved or recommended for other people at this time.
