Synopsis:

On 06/25/20 at approximately 2350 hours, Plumas County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 100 block of Brentwood Drive in Chester. The reporting party told the Dispatch Center there was a vehicle containing five suspects outside the residence threatening to kill her.

Prior to arrival of Deputies, reports of gunshots heard in the area were reported to Dispatch from neighboring residences on Brentwood Drive. A short time later, Seneca Hospital advised PCSO there was a male victim in the emergency room with a gunshot wound. The victim was transported to an out of county hospital for treatment.

Deputies arrived to the area and secured the scene. During the investigation, Deputies and Investigators from the PCSO Detective Unit determined Donald Curtis Cox was the suspect in the shooting incident and he was taken into custody and booked at the Plumas County Jail for 245(a)(2) PC (Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Firearm).

The investigation into the incident by the Plumas County Sheriff's Office is ongoing.
