

Request for Proposal: Correctional Dental Services

The Plumas County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the Plumas County Correctional Facility, and the inmates which are held in that facility. Among the responsibilities of the Plumas County Sheriff's Office is to provide quality, respectful dental services to the inmates of the facility.

The purpose for this Request for Proposal is to seek and enter into a contract with a professional dental services contractor.

Scope of Work

Services to be provided by the contractor to the Plumas County Correctional Facility, and the amounts of the services, shall be as follows, but not limited to:

- a. Provide routine dental screening on inmates in order to address oral hygiene, determine if extractions are needed or fill cavities where cost is less than extraction or deemed necessary.
- b. Provide full or partial dental prosthetics when needed in order to promote improved health.
- c. Provide hygiene education to inmates during the visit in order to improve the inmate's oral health care.
- d. Work in coordination with Medical Director and nursing staff at the Plumas County Correctional Facility in regards to inmate oral health.
- e. When possible, be available to see inmates on emergent dental procedures.
- f. Follow the National Commission on Correctional Health Care, (NCCHC) standards where possible.

Other Minimum Qualifications

All dental professionals providing service shall have all necessary licenses from the appropriate licensing agencies, and such licenses shall be current and in good standing. The contractor shall provide copies of those licenses to the Plumas County Sheriff's Office upon request.
