

List of Official Plumas County Holidays

The following holidays are official County holidays. On such holidays, an employee shall be entitled to time off with full pay if the employee is full-time probationary or permanent. If the employee is part-time probationary or permanent, then the employee shall be entitled to time off with pay prorated on a part-time basis.

On County holidays, extra-help and temporary employees shall receive time off without pay.

- (1) January 1, New Year's Day;
- (2) The third Monday in January, Martin Luther King's birthday;
- (3) February 12, Lincoln's birthday;
- (4) The third Monday in February, which is the legal observance of Washington's birthday;
- (5) The last Monday in May, which is the legal observance of Memorial Day;
- (6) June 19, Juneteenth;
- (7) July 4, Independence Day;
- (8) The first Monday in September, Labor Day;
- (9) The second Monday in October, Columbus Day;
- (10) November 11, Veterans' Day;
- (11) The day in November which is the legal observance of Thanksgiving;
- (12) The day in November following Thanksgiving;
- (13) December 24, Christmas Eve, except that when December 24 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday shall be designated as the Christmas Eve holiday, and when December 24 falls on a Friday, the preceding Thursday shall be the holiday;
- (14) December 25, Christmas Day; and
- (15) Every day appointed by the President of the United States or the Governor of this State as a special one-time-only holiday.

If January 1, February 12, June 19, July 4, November 11, or December 25 falls upon a Sunday, the Monday following shall be a holiday. If such foregoing date falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday.
