During the evening of 10/05/2022 the Plumas County Sheriff's Office took a report of a runaway/missing juvenile from the Portola area. The juvenile attended school on 10/05/2022 and then did not return home. Information gathered through the course of the investigation indicates the juvenile may be trying to go to southern California.

The juvenile is 17-year-old Daryln De Leon Sintuj of Cromberg, CA. She is described as having a medium-dark brown complexion, 5' 2" tall, 130 pounds. Daryln is considered to be at risk due to her age and has been entered into the Missing Persons System and the case remains active with attempts to locate Darlyn.
