Potential Projects



Telemedicine Restoration & Expansion

Description: The project aims to restore, expand, and provide greater access to Telemedicine services with the assistance of community providers including Plumas County Public Health, Plumas County Behavioral Health, Plumas Unified School District, Plumas Rural Services, and other partners.



Greenville Town Hall

Description: Construct replacement meeting hall at the current location, if possible, or find a site where a multi-use co-location building could be constructed. There is opportunity to pair with local infrastructure and other community functions to create a resilience hub. This is an opportunity to build back more sustainable than before and encourage more regular community involvement with supplemental programs and services, while also being a place of refuge during an emergency event, and a place of restoration during recovery.



Greenville Library

Description: This project would rebuild the Greenville Library. Plans will need to be drawn up on what the library will look like, including consulting with County Librarian on suggested additions and modifications to have the library better fit modern-day library requirements. The library could be co-located with another multi-use community building space. The library will need to have replacement collections, furniture, and other associated materials.



Greenville Wellness Center

Description: There is a tremendous need for the services that the Greenville Wellness Center offered. This project would rebuild the Wellness Center or co-locate with another multi-use community building space to re-establish and expand services including counseling, education, food assistance, fitness programs, and communal meeting space.



Greenville Safety Center (Sheriff's Substation, IVCSO Fire & PDH Ambulance)

Description: This project would rebuild emergency service facilities in Greenville. It is intended to construct a joint-use replacement facility at a site where a multi-use building could be constructed, such as the same lot being used for the temporary facilities along Highway 89. The current proposal is to combine the individual Sheriff Substation with a permanent firehall and Plumas District Hospital ambulance services.



Greenville Community Resilience Center

Description: This project aims to establish a multi-purpose facility to address community needs including emergency day-to-day uses, conference rooms, recreation, commercial kitchen, ADA accessibility, large parking capacity, and expand current programs and services including youth services, workforce training, entrepreneurship/small business classes, and financial education/literacy workshops.
