

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that an election will be held on November 7, 2023, within the boundaries of the Prattville-Almanor Fire Protection District, to approve a measure for the purpose of obtaining voter approval, by a two-thirds majority vote, of the following measure:

“Upon a two-thirds vote of approval, shall a special tax, replacing the current special tax of \$75.00 per year which expired on June 30, 2023, be imposed indefinitely starting July 1, 2024 for the specific purpose of emergency medical response, fire protection and prevention and hazardous materials response, and shall this tax be authorized in the amount of \$125.00 per year, with optional annual adjustments not exceeding three percent (3%), on each parcel of real property within the District, excluding those parcels exempt from property tax, said tax to be collected along with the Plumas County property taxes, and shall the District appropriations limit (spending limit) be raised by the amount of the annual proceeds from this special tax for the period this tax is in effect, which revenue shall be deposited into a specifically created account on which an annual report shall be made as required by Government Code Section 50075.3?”

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the dates for filing arguments for or against the measure is July 12, 2023 through July 21, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. Arguments may not exceed 300 words each and must be accompanied by a “Form Statement” available at [www.plumascounty.us](http://www.plumascounty.us), signed by each author. Rebuttals to arguments in favor or against the measure may not exceed 250 words and must be filed with the County Clerk by August 2, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. The office of the Plumas County Clerk Elections Division located in the Courthouse at 520 Main Street, Room 102, Quincy will be the processing place for all ballots from October 10, 2023 through November 7, 2023. Equipment testing will be September 26, 2023 and is open to the public. For more information, call (530) 283-6256.
