

## **TAYLORSVILLE CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS**

Nightly camping: Check-in time is 2:00pm. Check out time is Noon. Camping Fee of \$20.00 nightly will be charged. There will be a \$200.00 cleaning deposit per camp site for horses.

**Consecutive nightly stay is limited to 14 days in any 30 day period. This does not apply to work camps, firefighting activity and other related forest management activity.**

**Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am.** We prefer that you don't drive through camp during that time, however if you **MUST**, please drive slowly and be as quiet as possible.

**DO NOT** bring pets in the shower house.

**DO NOT** wash cooking utensils in the restrooms.

**DO NOT** disrespect other guests and their families with rude, obnoxious, or unruly behavior. Example: excessive drunkenness or excessive noise.

You **MUST** clean up immediately after your pet(s) in accordance with Plumas County Code 6-1.119.

No trailer or vehicle washing allowed.

Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

One RV and one vehicle allowed per camp site.

**CAMPFIRES ARE PERMITTED IN FIRE RINGS ONLY. DO NOT LEAVE CAMPFIRES UNATTENDED.**

**DO NOT CUT DOWN TREES OR FENCES FOR FIREWOOD.**

Dump station fee is \$5 and is located on the South East side of campground behind the Restrooms & Shower.

**RV's are not allowed** continuous hook-up to hose bibs. Fill up your tank and disconnect, please, to allow others access to water.

**ALL FIREWORKS ARE PROHIBITED.**

In order for everyone to have the opportunity to enjoy their time while at the campground, Plumas County reserves the right to ask anyone to leave without a refund and any applicable deposit if found disrespecting guests and facilities.

**Food must be stored in a manner that makes it inaccessible to wildlife. Bears and Mountain Lions roam this area.**

**All other state and federal laws and regulations apply.**

***Taylorsville Campground is not responsible for accidents, lost or stolen articles at your campsite or in any of the common areas of the campground.***

The Camp Host will be monitoring and enforcing Campground Rules and Policies. Failure to adhere to the above listed rules & policy may result in removal of the offender(s) by the Plumas County Sheriff. Those offenders will not be permitted to return for future stays or events.

**Taylorsville Campground reserves the right to reject entry to the facility.**
