As a citizen of Indian Valley I am asking that the meeting to be held tomorrow at the Mineral Building will be held strictly to the issue of Vesting Rights. Public comment as to ways and means of mining, the "what if"s, is irrelevant to Vesting Rights. These issues should be a part of any hearings by other permitting agencies in regards to reclamation environmental, etc.

I would hope that the planning department determination of Vesting Rights is not based upon "feelings of what if" but based on facts of the information provided on the application only.

In discussions with other individuals, I have pointed out that the report included with the application by US Copper is dated March 2018, the only static information in it is the geological information, that the shown engineering plans are all subject to change as means and methods may have changed in order to meet Best Engineering and Management Practices. It is also relevant that the document is informational only to determine the viability to investors and companies involved with the project. Thus my request for discussion only related to vesting rights.
