FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – APRIL 25, 2024

The County of Plumas received a letter, addressed to the Interim Zoning Administrator, Jim Graham, dated April 25, 2024, from US Copper Corp. CEO, Steve Dunn, on behalf of U.S. Copper Corp. and the California-Engels Mining Co. stating the formal withdrawal, without prejudice, of its Verified Request for Determination of Vested Rights for the Engels-Superior Mines application originally submitted on April 25, 2023, and amended on June 27, 2023.

As a result of the withdrawal, the Plumas County Planning Department has ceased processing the application and will remove the item from the regularly scheduled May 8, 2024, Zoning Administrator meeting, without rescheduling.
