

## **RESOLUTION NO. 25-\_\_\_\_\_**

### **A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A REVISED FEE SCHEDULE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS SELF-HAULING GREEN WASTE TO THE CHESTER GREEN WASTE PROGRAM LOCATED AT THE CHESTER LANDFILL**

WHEREAS, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors, on June 6, 2023, did adopt a Memorandum of Understanding, thus establishing terms for the operation of the Chester Green Waste Program, and

WHEREAS, a nexus study performed by Plumas County Department of Public Works found that the current rate of \$5 per cubic yard was insufficient to cover Plumas County's costs of running the Chester Green Waste Program, and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing held during a public meeting of the Plumas County Board of Supervisors on May \_\_\_, 2025, the Board of Supervisors received evidence of the actual cost to operate the Chester Green Waste Program and received written and oral arguments for and against an increase in the rate to dispose of green waste at the Chester Landfill, and

WHEREAS, notice of such public hearing was given by publication in the \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, 2025, and

WHEREAS, it is the conclusion of the Board of Supervisors, based on the evidence presented at the public hearing, that a fee increase at the Chester Green Waste Program is necessary for the sustainable operation of the Chester Green Waste Program

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas that,

- (a) The above recitals are true and correct.
- (b) That fee for disposal of green waste at the Green Waste Collection area of the Chester Landfill shall be \$7 per cubic yard.
