As required by the California Accidental Release Prevention program, a Risk Management Plan (RMP) for the following facility has been accepted as complete by PCEH per CCR 5070.2(a) and is now available to the public for review and comment:

Chester Public Utility District uses gaseous chlorine and sulfur dioxide for wastewater treatment. Based on the volumes of the acutely hazardous materials, a RMP is required for this facility per CCR 5050.1.

The public review period is 45 days from the date of this notice. Any interested party may review and comment on these plans at the PCEH office at 270 County Hospital Road, Suite 127, Quincy CA. The PCEH office is open Monday through Friday, 8AM to 5PM. Appointments must be arranged in advance for these reviews.
