NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code, that at the California Primary Election held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors have called for a measure for the purpose of obtaining voter approval, by a majority vote of the following measure:

“Shall a measure authorizing the County of Plumas to impose a transactions and use tax in the total amount of one percent (1.0%) to be used to maintain and enhance the quality of life of the citizens in Plumas County be approved by enacting a one percent (1.0%) transactions and use tax providing approximately \$3,000,000 annually in general revenue to Plumas County, to be levied until ended in 12 years?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the dates for filing arguments for or against the measure is January 12, 2026 through January 21, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Arguments may not exceed 300 words each and must be accompanied by a “Author Form - Arguments” available at www.plumascounty.us, signed by each author. Rebuttals to arguments in favor or against the measure may not exceed 250 words and must be filed with the County Clerk by February 2, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. The office of the Plumas County Clerk Elections Division located in the Courthouse at 520 Main Street, Room 102, Quincy.
